

Parent/Carer feedback forms from parents' evening

- Mrs Cain spoke through the answers that were given.
- Lots of positive feedback in respect of feeling safe and confident to talk about what they feel.
- Discussion on safety online and the types of protection on child exploitation. Discussions with children starts in Year 4/5 on the online safety with respect to staying safe. The “PANTS” rule is taught.
- Musically discussed and school position was talked through.
- Some comments on progress. A parent asked for a termly report. School feel that unless there are specific details/issues that this is currently sufficient.
- End of year reports discussed in respect of language used.
- Copy and pasted comments were notices and some comments had the wrong names on.
- Review generic comments on the reports.
- Clarify statements on emerging etc.
- Children were thought to be supported well within lessons.
- Some comments regarding behaviour. Some children get extra rewards for certain activities eg sitting still at times when required. This makes some children jealous. Mrs Cain to discuss with the staff and to check that it is not inadvertently demoralising other children.
- Friendship week discussed.
- School photos well received. Parents liked the photos being emailed. They feel that the blue background needs to be changed on the group photos.



Improvements suggested within the survey

These were talked through and points suggested:

- Online workshops
- Tree survey is being done

- BH playground equipment has been ordered
- More sports clubs this year
- RW3 door is to be moved to make intake easier. Suggestion on double gates to help pushchairs get through
- Parent forum on different days
