End of Key Stage 1 Assessments...

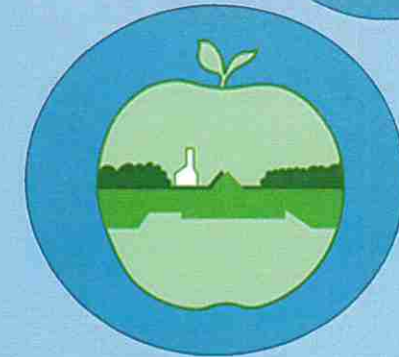
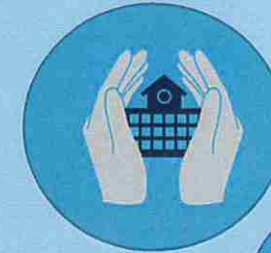


During May, there are national tests in reading and maths for children in Year 2. These tests are carried out in a way that reflects the young age of the children and are used to inform teacher assessments.
