Progress

Headlines

- PP pupils make the same progress in reading and writing , less in Maths
- In percentage terms PP pupils make a significantly higher percentage of accelerated progress than all pupils in reading and writing and on par in maths

Headlines

- Attainment is still the challenge for the PP pupils in the school. Accelerated learning is needed to ensure attainment increases. In the above table, there is 15-23% accelerated learning for PP pupils.
- Although attainment is a concern for those PP children who are below expected for attainment, their needs are being addressed through targeted catch up by staff as demonstrated in the Pupils Monitoring Tool documents by each class teacher.

Well-being interventions

Well-Being Interventions for PP pupils

All PP pupils have maintained their well-being or have increased.

- Listening Ear- there has been a 43% increase in their Leuven Scale
- Lego Therapy – there has been a 100% increase in their Leuven Scale
- Emotional Literacy – there has been a 67% increase in their Leuven Scale
- Counselling - there has been a 67% increase in their Leuven scale

Attendance

- The school is following the attendance guidelines whilst we are partially closed. There are two attendance registers. One is for the government and one is for Kent. From the 1st June, the school has had to complete the class registers and the two returns one for the government and then one for Kent County Council.
