


This week, for the blog we visited the formal Year 4s. First, in maths, they have been challenging themselves to work out area.




I cannot make a large square using an odd number of smaller squares.

Do you agree with Whitney? *No* ✓

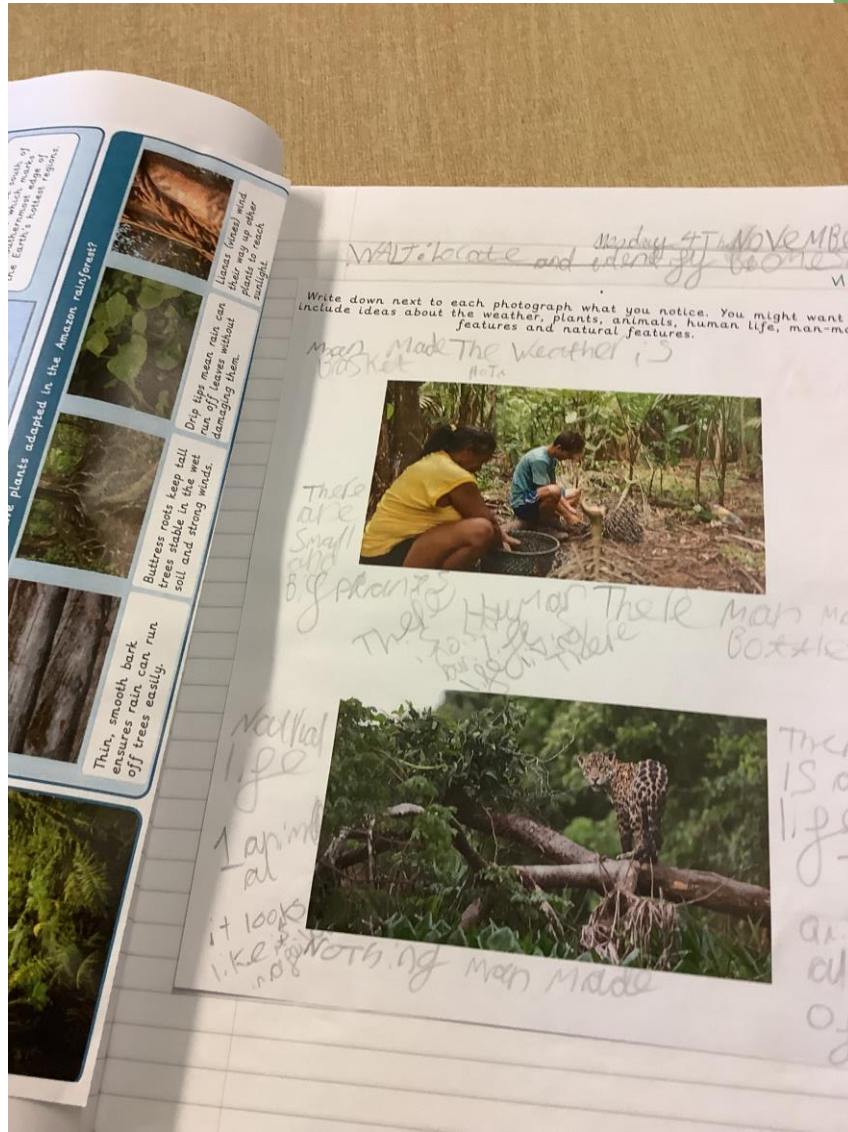
Draw a picture to support your answer. *You could do 9 by 9* ✓

Make as many different rectilinear shapes with the squares as you can.

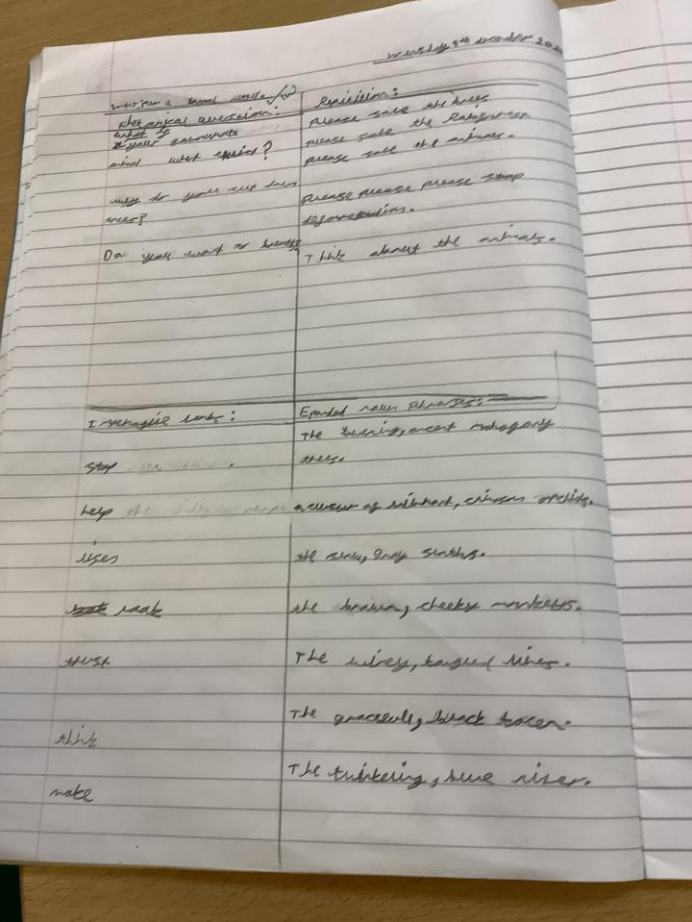
Draw some of your shapes.



Topic

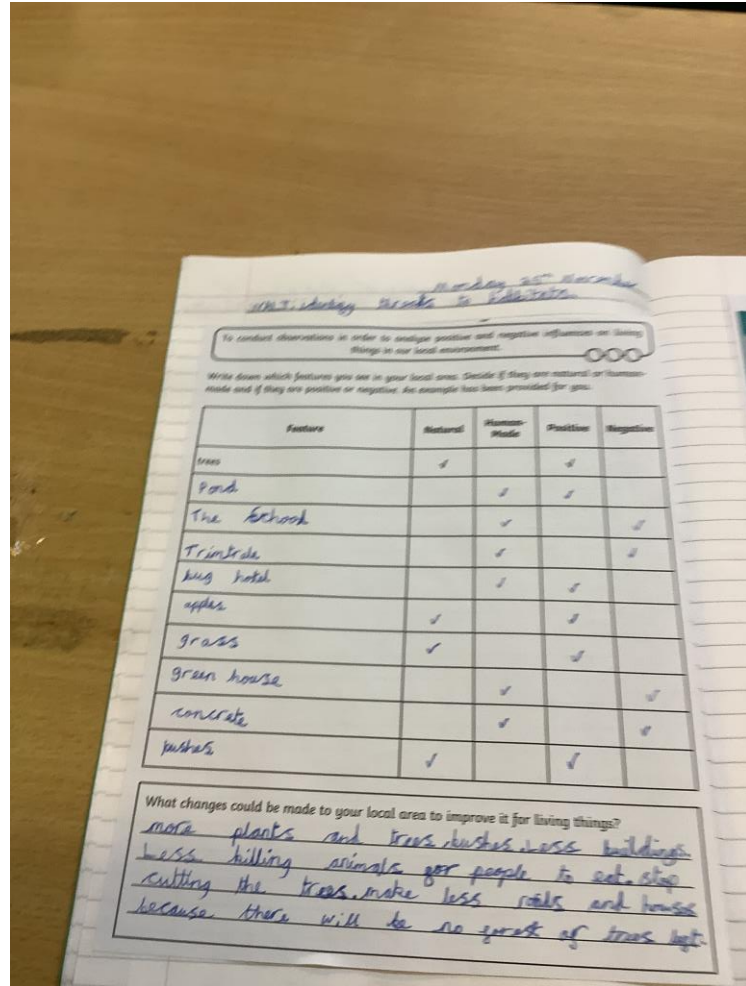
Then, in topic, they have been learning all about the rainforest and deforestation.
